Film Companies Scouting Lake Lucerne

As anyone who watches even a little TV knows, the greater Atlanta metropolitan area has become home to a wide variety and a large number of shows; The Walking Dead, Vampire Diaries, Drop Dead Diva, and Stranger Things all are (or were) filmed almost exclusively in and around the metro-Atlanta area. In fact, film and television production has moved into the area in such a big way, industry insiders have nicknamed Atlanta, "Y'all-ywood."

Recently, scouts for the Netflix hit series, Ozark, have approached our community, asking about using Lake Lucerne as a shooting location. Created by Bill Dubuque (who also produced "The Accountant," and "The Judge"), this drama series stars Jason Bateman

as Marty Byrde, a financial planner who relocates his family from Chicago to a summer resort community in the Ozarks. With wife Wendy and their two kids in tow, Marty is on the move after a money-laundering scheme goes wrong, forcing him to pay off a substantial debt to a Mexican drug lord in order to keep his family safe. While the Byrde's fate hangs in the balance, the dire circumstances force the fractured family to reconnect.

Producers approached Little Lake Events to inquire about the possibility of taking over the clubhouse and the lake for 6 days and nights of filming. Ultimately, another location was selected and the film crew withdrew their offer for the

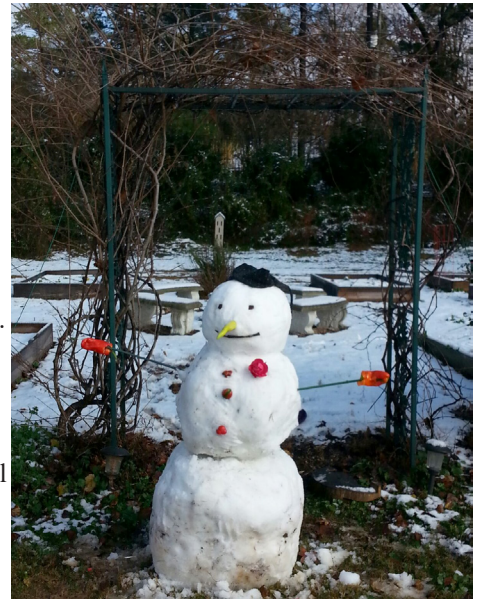
Garden Plots Available
